## 2021 Birdman Sauvignon Blanc



### RANGE

Anakena Birdman is named after the “Tangata Manu”, a figure from Rapa Nui belief, the Birdman symbolises determination and resilience in his pursuit of the coveted egg.

### GRAPE VARIETY

Sauvignon Blanc

### COLOUR

Bright pale straw colour with hints of green.

### NOSE

Fresh aromas of pineapple and passionfruit, with notes of green pepper.

### PALATE

Bursting with tropical and herbaceous flavours, all underpinned by a clean refreshing acidity and a bright finish.

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Chile’s Mediterranean climate combines the warm, dry summers and cold, rainy winters that are ideal for growing wine grapes. The country’s unusual geography gives the perfect balance between cool sea breezes from the Pacific and protection from the coastal and Andes mountain ranges. Deep, well drained alluvial soils in the valleys are ideal for producing intensely flavoured grapes with fresh natural acidity.

The 2021 vintage season started well, with a mild spring after some reasonable rains during winter. Spring was marred by a few isolated frosts but overall harvest was one of the largest on record. 2021 will be remembered for its fresh floral whites and beautifully mature reds with excellent colour and structure.
